Homework Menu

Our homework expectations...

- *reading at home at least 3 times a week,*
- *Spelling task,*
- *practicing times tables (TT Rockstars, times tables songs)*
- *completing the KIRF (Key Instant Recall Fact) set each half term*

We have also given our homework menu. This can be done with adult support at home. Column A are English tasks, Column B are more creative. We ask pupils to have a go at at least one from each column.

<u>Animal Fact File</u> Write a fact file for a chosen animal. The information should be written under sub-headings, one of which should be 'Diet'.	<u>Skeletons</u> Draw or create a model of an animal's skeleton.
<u>Pet Food Diary</u> Keep a record/ diary of everything your pet eats and drinks. Try to include details such as when , what and how much they eat and drink. If you do not have a pet, you could do this for a neighbour's/ friend's pet.	<u>Animal Pictures</u> Draw a series of animals. Find out what they eat and label them with 'carnivore', 'herbivore' or 'omnivore'.
<u>Amazing Animal Quiz</u> Create a quiz about animals- perhaps some unusual animals. This could include having a set of fun facts about different animals then a series of questions related to your fun facts to test your friends.	<u>Junk Model Animals</u> Create a model of a chosen animal using recycled equipment such as cardboard boxes etc. The models should be no bigger than 30cm x 30cm.
We like you to be creative – we are quite open to you coming up with your own idea and sharing 😊
