Homework Menu

Children can choose **two** activities from the selection of tasks below to complete by the end of the topic. One of the activities should be a Literacy (*) based task.

Create a 'What am I?' quiz by selecting parts of the digestive system and then describing them in turn with clues.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Create a word search or crossword puzzle containing some of the key topic vocabulary you have learned related to digestion. Ask a friend or family member to solve it! (*)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Find a recipe for a dish that is good for your digestion. Now cook or bake it! Record your experience, maybe including some photos or drawings.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Use books or internet to research teeth. Create a poster to explain why brushing and looking after your teeth is so important! e.g. How long should they be brushed for? How often? (*)</p>
<p>Drop grubby copper-plated coins (1p or 2p) into a range of fizzy drinks and leave them overnight to see what happens. Which brand has the most powerful cleaning properties? How might this affect your teeth?!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Make a model of the digestive system using recyclable materials.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Create a poster to persuade people to look after their teeth. Why is it important to take care of our teeth? (*)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Draw a diagram of the mouth and label the teeth: molars, pre-molars, incisors and canines</p>
