<p><u>Short Story</u></p> <p>Can you write a short story set in a Cornish Tin Mine which you can read to the class?</p>	<p><u>Make and Do</u></p> <p>Build a famous Cornish Tin Mine. What resources could you use? e.g. Lego, card, papier mache, Minecraft</p>
<p><u>Diary Entry</u></p> <p>Write a diary entry by pretending you are someone who has just experienced a day mining. Remember to include what happened and how you were feeling.</p>	<p><u>Food</u></p> <p>Can you bake a traditional Cornish food? Show everyone what you've done e.g. Pasty, Hevva Cake etc...</p>
<p><u>Mine Information Leaflet</u></p> <p>Create an information leaflet about mines. This could include facts about the different types, how they are used, how they change over time etc...</p>	<p><u>Rock Art</u></p> <p>Produce some pebble art. Can you draw a miner, tin mine or similar on a rock?</p>
<p><u>Own Choice</u></p> <p>Could you choose your own homework? What else could you do related to our topic? Have a think and impress your classmates!</p>
