
TARGET:

Top Tips...the secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely.

- Practise Key Facts while walking to school or during a car journey.
- Have a fact of the day.
- Buy one get three free If your child knows one fact (e.g. 81 +19 = 100), can they tell you the other three facts in the same fact family?
- They should be able to answer questions including missing number questions e.g. $49 \text{ } \bigcirc$ = 100 or 100 \bigcirc = 72
- Play games to support your child in maths. Your child has access to Times Tables
