By the end of this term children should be able to:

Top Tips...the secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely.

- Practise Key Facts while walking to school or during a car journey.
- Have a fact of the day.
- Buy one get three free** - If your child knows one fact (e.g. $81 + 19 = 100$), can they tell you the other three facts in the same fact family?
- They should be able to answer questions including missing number questions e.g. $49 + \text{○} = 100$ or $100 - \text{○} = 72$
- Play games - to support your child in maths. Your child has access to **Times Tables Rock Stars**, **Purple Mash** and the **White Rose 1 minute App** (<https://whiterosemaths.com/resources/1-minute-maths#download>) is brilliant for building number confidence and fluency.

$$100 - 63 = 37$$

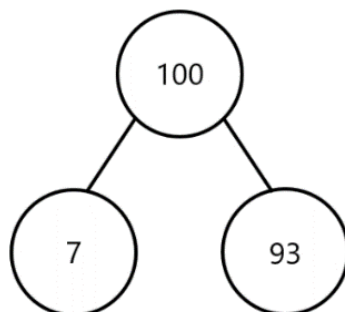
$$100 - 37 = 63$$

$$48 + 52 = 100$$

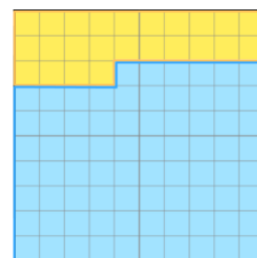
$$52 + 48 = 100$$
