Top Tips...the secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely.

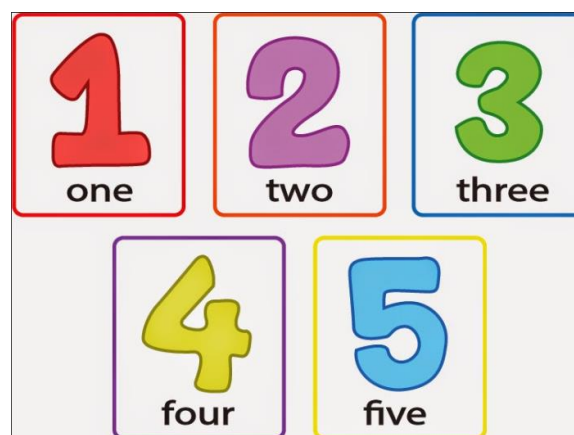
- Practise Key Facts while walking to school or during a car journey.
