## Stone Age – Iron Age Homework Menu

### Our homework expectations...

We have also given our homework menu. This can be done with adult support at home. Column A are English tasks, Column B are more creative. We ask pupils to have a go at at least one from each column.

Write your own recipe for a stone age dinner using the sort of ingredients that would be available to them.	<u>Stone Age jewellery</u> Make a stone age necklace or bracelet. <u>Time Traveller</u> Imagine that you have been whisked back in time to a Stone Age camp. You have been allowed to take one person or one object from 2016. What would you take and how would you explain your choice to the stone Age people?	<u>Cave art</u> Make up your own story, it can be about anything you like but tell it through cave art pictures!
<u>Cave homes</u> During the Stone Age, people lived in caves. If you had to live in a cave what would you like it to look like and what would be in it? Describe it in as much detail as you can.	<u>Cave homes</u> During the Stone Age, people lived in caves. Be as creative and imaginative as you like! Build your own 3D cave! (No bigger than a shoe box)
We like you to be creative – we are quite open to you coming up with your own Stone Age idea and sharing 😊
