The School Day

Reception to Year Six

The school gates for all pupils open at 8.45am. Registration is at 8:55am. The School day ends at 3:00pm for Tater Du (EYFS), 3:05pm for Longships and Round Island (KS1) and 3:10pm for Sevenstones, Bishop Rock, Godrevy and Wolf Rock (KS2).

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is available, at a charge of £2.00, between 8.00am and 8.40am. Children can be dropped off up to 8.30a.m. There is no need to book. Payments should be made via Parentmail

Morning Break

All Key Stage 1 and 2 pupils have a 15 minute break each morning at 10.30 am. A piece of fruit is supplied for each child in EYFS and KS1 through the county fruit scheme. Key Stage 2 children can bring a healthy snack e.g. fruit, cereal bar, frube etc...

Lunch

Reception and Year 1 break for lunch 11:50am and 12:50pm. The rest of the school breaks for lunch between 12.00pm and 1.00pm.

Drop-off and collection

At the beginning of the school day **8.45a.m** children should be dropped off at the following points:

Reception class (Tater Du) - Drop off at the Top Gate. Collection at 3:00pm at Main Gate

- Y1 (Longships) Drop off at main gate. Collection at 3:05pm at Main Gate
- Y2 (Round Island) Drop off at the Side Gate (opposite the school field). Collection 3:05pm at Side Gate
- Y3 (Sevenstones) Drop off at Main Gate. Collection 3.10pm at Main Gate
- Y4 (Bishop's Rock), Y5 (Godrevy) & Y6 (Wolf Rock) Drop off at Side Gate. Collection at Side Gate 3.10pm

After School Clubs

If your child is attending an after school club you will receive information detailing the time it will finish and where your child should be collected.
