Top Tips...the secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely.

- Practise Key Facts while walking to school or during a car journey.
- Have a fact of the day.
- **Pronunciation**: Make sure that your child is pronouncing the numbers correctly and not getting confused between thirteen and thirty; nineteen and ninety.

- If your child creates their own song, this can make the times tables even more memorable.
- Play games to support your child in maths. Your child has access to Times Tables

| How many spots do 3 ladybirds have? | 2 + 2 + 2 = | 3 × 2 = |
|-------------------------------------|---------------------|---------|
| How many spots do 4 ladybirds have? | 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = | 4 × 2 = |
| How many spots do 5 ladybirds have? | 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = | 5 × 2 = |
