### TARGET:

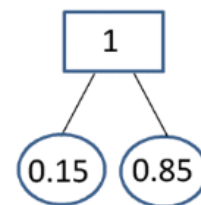
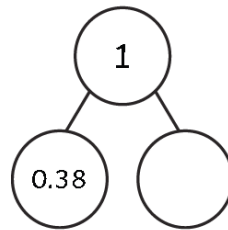
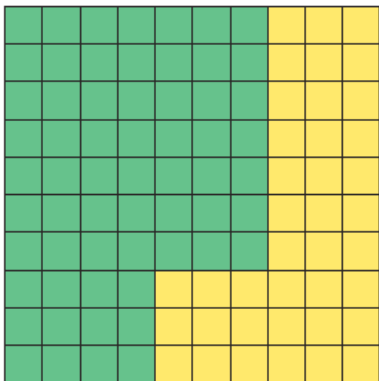
- To know pairs of decimal numbers to 2 decimal place that make 1.

### By the end of this term children should be able to:

- To recall all decimal numbers pairs that make 1. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

Decimals number Bonds to 1 are pairs of decimal numbers that add together to make 1.

Write the complement to 1 that is shown.



$$0.15 + 0.85 = 1$$

$$0.85 + 0.15 = 1$$

$$1 - 0.15 = 0.85$$

$$1 - 0.85 = 0.15$$
