Find out about Anglo-Saxon weapons and create a fact sheet with illustrations.	Write your own version of the epic poem, Beowulf. Use as much description as possible to make the battle scenes exciting. (*)	Try an Anglo-Saxon recipe. Perhaps you could research and cook an Anglo-Saxon dish at home. Take a photo when you are finished.	Make a 3D model of an Anglo-Saxon settlement.
