Which is smaller - 5 or $13 ?$
By the end of this term children should be able to:

- Count objects to 20,
- Recognise the numbers to 20,
- Recall what comes before or after a number to 20,

Top Tips...the secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely.

- Practise Key Facts while walking to school or during a car journey.
- Have a fact of the day.
- Perhaps you could have number cards that you can show your child and they say which number is larger or smaller.
- Maybe use a number line to help compare the size of numbers
