### TARGET:

- To count, recognise and recall numbers and numerals to 20.

### By the end of this term children should be able to:

- Count objects to 20,
- Recognise the numbers to 20,
- Recall what comes before or after a number to 20,

#### Key Vocabulary

Which is **bigger** - 12 or 4?

Which is **smaller** - 5 or 13?

What comes next...11, 12, 13...?

### Top Tips...the secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely.

- Practise Key Facts while walking to school or during a car journey.
- Have a fact of the day.
- Perhaps you could have number cards that you can show your child and they say which number is larger or smaller.
- Maybe use a number line to help compare the size of numbers
- Play games - to support your child in maths your child has access to **Numbots**, **Purple Mash** and the White Rose 1 minute App (<https://whiterosemaths.com/resources/1-minute-maths#download>) is brilliant for building number confidence and fluency.

Children should be able to start at one and then count on:

**6 7 8 9 10**  
**11 12 13 14**  
**15 16 17 18**  
**19 20**
