

Your School's Key Stage 2 Data

We have used your 2022 Key Stage 2 results to create your school and group level averages. It is important to note that:

- Pupil characteristics have been sourced in line with DfE methodology:
 - "Disadvantaged" pupils are those who have been eligible for free school meals in the last six years, pupils with post-looked after arrangements, and children in care.
 - Disadvantaged status is derived from a combination of DfE pupil Premium data (June 2022) and locally held CiC data. Numbers may vary slightly to official published figures, however we hope this will provide a useful indicator of outcomes for this key group. You can find the latest DfE pupil premium list for the current financial year on Corestats.
 - Pupil's SEN status and Prior Attainment is official DfE data, taken from the Spring 2022 School Census.
- Mobile Pupils includes any pupils who joined the school from September 2020 onwards. Pupils At School Since EY includes those who joined on or before September 2015. In most cases pupils entry dates are based on your **school census data**. However, where a school has become an academy/changed MIS and de-registered/re-registered all pupils, we have taken steps to source the correct entry dates for each pupil based on Council records.
- All test outcomes and scaled scores include any adjustments made where special consideration has been granted by the DfE.
- Low, middle and high prior attainment bands have been calculated in line with the DfE's new 2022 progress methodology, and may vary slightly from official figures.
- We have calculated your school's progress scores in line with the DfE's new 2022 progress methodology. This is not official DfE data and may vary slightly from Analyse School Performance (ASP). For more information about how progress has been calculated, please see the Key Stage 2 Accountability & Methodology 2022 document.

Which Comparators have we used?

Due to the availability of national data at the time of this release, we have used provisional DfE national data where possible. We have indicated in the comparator cohort which source we have used:

DfE: indicates that this is DfE provisional national value.

NCER: indicates that this is the indicative value based on data from 134 LAs.

LA: Where there is no national DfE or NCER comparator available, we have used LA data for comparison. Please note that LA outcomes are slightly below the national average, so additional caution should be used.

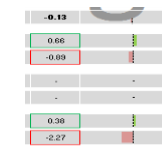

Significance testing has been applied to progress for all pupil groups. 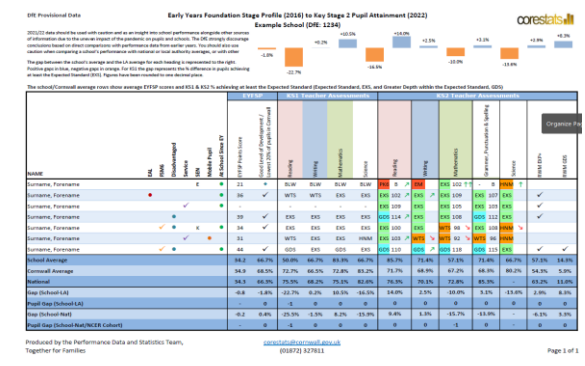

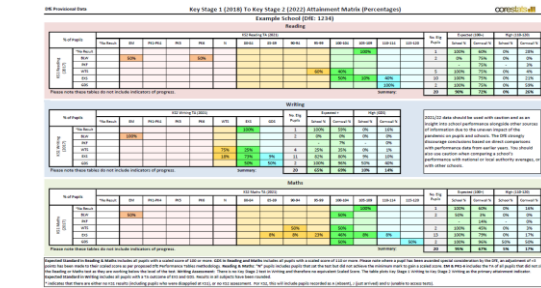
